



GARBAGE COLLECTION GUIDELINES FOR THE TOWN OF MONCKS CORNER FOR RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES

RESIDENTIAL: In accordance with the Town of Moncks Corner/Suburban Container Company contract, each household will obtain at least one (1) ninety-six (96) gallon roll cart for household garbage, and will be provided household garbage service a maximum of one (1) time per week. All household garbage must be placed inside the roll cart and placed curbside **NO LATER THAN 6:00 a.m.** Plastic bags will NOT be collected unless they are placed inside the roll cart. Carts must be placed as close to the roadside as practical without interfering with or endangering the movement of vehicles or pedestrians. Contractor may decline to collect any cart not so placed.

COMMERCIAL: Commercial curbside garbage will be collected twice (2) per week. All garbage **MUST** be placed inside the ninety-six (96) gallon roll cart and placed curbside **NO LATER THAN 8:30 a.m.** on collection day. Carts must be placed as close to the roadside as practical without interfering with or endangering the movement of vehicles or pedestrians. Contractor may decline to collect any cart not so placed.

ADDITIONAL ROLL CARTS FOR GARBAGE DISPOSAL may be obtained, from the Moncks Corner town office, by application and a \$35.00 non-refundable deposit. An additional cost of \$10.00 per month for residential and \$15.00 per month for commercial will be added to your water bill for the service.

FURTHER GUIDELINES UNDER TOWN OF M.C. CONTRACT



YARD DEBRIS: Leaves, grass and/or pine straw are collected on Friday. Yard debris must be placed in brown paper lawn bags or a pile no larger than 10'LX4'WX3'H. **WHEELBARROWS WILL NOT BE DUMPED.** Limbs and cuttings must not exceed four inches in diameter and four feet in length and 40 pounds in weight. Yard debris mingled with garbage will not be picked up.

CARDBOARD BOXES: Must be broken-down and placed inside roll carts.

BULK ITEMS: Metal appliances, such as refrigerators, washers, dryers, stoves, etc. will be collected Fridays **AFTER** all yard debris has been picked up. Furniture and other **non-metal** items such as vacuum cleaners, bicycle tires, small BBQ grills, etc. and must be placed at curbside on your roll cart collection day. Contractor will **NOT** pick up construction debris i.e. lumber, windows, doors, etc.
