

Camp Itinerary

- Monday June 6th: Children should be dropped off at 8:00 am at Berkeley Intermediate School. This day the children will spend time learning about and participating in various types of law enforcement demonstrations and activities. Parents can pick their children up at the Intermediate school at 4:00.
- Tuesday June 7th: Children should be dropped off at 8:00 am at Berkeley Intermediate School. This day the children will be taken on buses to Wannamaker Park in N. Charleston, where they will spend the remainder of the day before returning to the Intermediate school for pickup. Parents can pick their children up at the Intermediate school at 4:00.
- Wednesday June 8th: Children should be dropped off at 8:00 am at Berkeley Intermediate School. This day the children will be taken on buses to the Music in Motion skating rink where they will spend the majority of the day. Parents can pick their children up at the Intermediate school at 4:00.
- Thursday June 9th: Children should be dropped off at 8:00 am at Berkeley Intermediate School. This day the children will be taken on buses to Bee City in Cottageville where they will spend the majority of the day. Parents can pick their children up at the Intermediate school at 4:00.
- Friday June 10th: Children should be dropped off at 8:00 am at Berkeley Intermediate School. The first part of the day will be spent at Swamp Fox Bowling Alley then the second part of the day will be spent at the Intermediate school where the children will play on jump castles, have a pizza party and participate in final camp ceremonies. Parents can pick their children up at the Intermediate school at 4:00.
